

The VA Illiana Health Care System (VAIHCS) conducted a ground breaking ceremony for VA Building Utilization Review and Repurposing (BURR) Ground Breaking Initiative on Tuesday, July 21, 2015 on what was once the golf course on the VA campus in Danville, Illinois.

The proposed Permanent Housing Enhanced-Use Lease development will consist of 65 units (1, 2, and 3 bedroom units) on approximately 10.64 acres of land.

In attendance local VAIHCS Leadership, VAIHCS employees, Veterans, Veteran Service Organizations, elected officials and our partners Mercy Housing Lakefront, the Danville Veterans Housing Permanent Housing Enhanced-Use Lease (EUL) and the Danville Housing Authority.

The community support behind VA's Enhanced-Use Lease (EUL) authority and Building Utilization Review and Repurposing (BURR) initiative is tremendous as we move closer to providing at-risk of homelessness and chronically homeless Veterans with even greater access to care and treatment to help them attain long-term independence and self-sufficiency.
